

Day 1: Uluru

Day 2: Uluru



Journey to the sacred domes of Kata Tjuta with your local guide and explore the breathtaking Walpa Gorge, a desert oasis for a variety of plants and animals.

Enjoy a laid-back picnic lunch before meeting your camel for a gentle trek across the red earth. Then saddle up and sway through the landscape as your guide shares the fascinating history of camels in Australia, how these desert giants arrived in the 19th century and became essential to outback exploration. It's a delicious pause and a one-of-a-kind ride into the country's past.

Reflect on your day as you relish sunset drinks and dinner under a blanket of stars. Immerse yourself in the spectacular Field of Light art installation that lights up the desert night in colour.


Day 3: Uluru



Enjoy a catered lunch at the Cultural Art Centre before learning the ancient art of dot painting with Anangu artists. Hear stories that guide each pattern and color as you create your own canvas alive with desert hues. Be inspired and connect with the world's oldest living culture through art and storytelling.



As the desert blushes at sunset, a private sand dune becomes your dining room. Champagne in hand, watch Uluru glow ember-red as the sky deepens to indigo. A four-course feast of native ingredients unfolds while the Milky Way spills across the heavens. Stories of Anangu culture weave through the night, and every bite feels like a love letter to the outback.
