Day 1: Alice Springs




West MacDonnell Ranges

Fly to Owen Springs Reserve for an exhilarating tag-along 4WD expedition through the West MacDonnell Ranges. Navigate the dry riverbed to the picturesque Ellery Creek Big Hole, stopping at the fascinating Ochre Pits and the spectacular Ormiston Gorge.

Continue your 4WD journey downstream along the Finke, pausing to explore along the way. See giant craters formed by meteorites at Henbury Conservation Reserve. Arrive at Kings Canyon Resort in Watarrka National Park in the late afternoon.

Day 4: Kings Canyon



Immerse yourself in the rugged beauty of the outback on the three-hour Kings Canyon Rim Walk. Feel the power of nature as you trace the canyon's soaring sandstone walls, stumble upon hidden waterholes, and wander through pockets of lush, unexpected greenery.

Climb aboard a buggy at Kings Creek Station for an adrenaline-charged tour of the property.

Connect with the Aboriginal Traditional Owners of the Wanmarra Community through Karrke Aboriginal Cultural Tours. Learn how language and culture are carefully preserved, and experience the knowledge of seasonal bush tucker and traditional bush medicines.

Recharge and reconnect with nature when you spend the night in a safari tent at the Mort Conway Camp on Kings Creek Station.



Day 5: Alice Springs



Mountain Biking

Be struck by the beauty and imposing presence of the West MacDonnell Ranges during a guided walk through Standley Chasm. A haven for native plants and animals, this striking geological formation is also an important cultural place to the Arrernte people, the Traditional Owners of this land. Connect with Aboriginal artists onsite in a dot painting workshop, then enjoy a bush-tucker inspired picnic lunch at Standley Chasm.
