


Day 2: Nitmiluk

Spend the afternoon celebrating the Northern Territory's rich pastoral heritage with an engaging show at Katherine Outback Experience.






Day 3: Nitmiluk





Day 4: Kakadu




Jim Jim Falls, Kakadu National Park
