
Take in a spectacular Darwin sunset and delicious meal at the Trailer Boat Club, then let your hair down at a Beach Party.



Try your hand at basket weaving, clap stick painting and spear throwing. Learn about bush tucker, bush medicines and the rich local Aboriginal culture.

Travel one hour out of Darwin to board a private boat cruise on the picturesque Corroboree Billabong where you'll find an abundance of local wildlife including saltwater crocodiles and a variety of bird species.
